

If your Apria Sleep Therapy User Guide.) you received a mask with multiple cushions, See User Guide page 10 follow these instructions: There is a mask cushion currently attached to the frame of your mask. This size fits most patients. Once you begin therapy, if your mask is leaking or feels uncomfortable, try removing the existing cushion and replacing it with a different size cushion. If you are between sizes, it is best to use the larger cushion. Use the Fitting Lie down and take four deep breaths. Template (for nasal mask and full face mask) 12 and/or the manufacturer's instructions included The machine should start automatically. If you do with your mask for help. not hear the machine start, press the Start Therapy/Standby button. Relax and begin to take See User Guide page 6 slow breaths through your nose. See User Guide page 12 Check for air leaks. 13 Small leaks are acceptable. If large leaks occur, consult your Apria Sleep Therapy User Guide.
