Rhino trapeze bar will allow patients to lift themselves while in bed.


Please read through this manual and get acquainted with your patient trapeze bar. Follow the maintenance schedule to ensure proper function of your unit.


## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

7. Attach the Trapeze Grab Bar to the Trapeze Holder, then tighten it. Check all bolts to make sure that they are all tighten.



## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

- A. Please carefully unpack the container and remove the patient Lifter from the shipping carton.
- B. Inspect the packaging, make sure there's no shipping damage and all the components are in the shipping carton.
  - 2. Floor Bases.
  - 1 Triangle Frame.
  - 1. Up-right Frame.
  - 1 Trapeze Grab Bar (with chain)
  - 3 Completed Screw-washer-nut-bolt sets.

- 2. Assistance is needed and highly recommended due to the heavy weight of parts in completing the final assembly.



- 4. Repeat step 1 to 3 for the other floor base.






Figure 3 Figure 4

5. Insert Up-right Frame to the top of the Triangle Base.


